# Type Approval Key Points

- Affects everyone involved in manufacturing, building, converting, importing and selling vehicles
- All aspects of the vehicle covered by technical regulations must be approved
- Plan ahead!
  - Customer bespoke requirements may impact technical compliance
    - These can be covered by IVA if required (leadtime)
    - Careful planning for the scope of your approval can help
- No Approval – No Sale!
  - Will not be able to register a new vehicle
